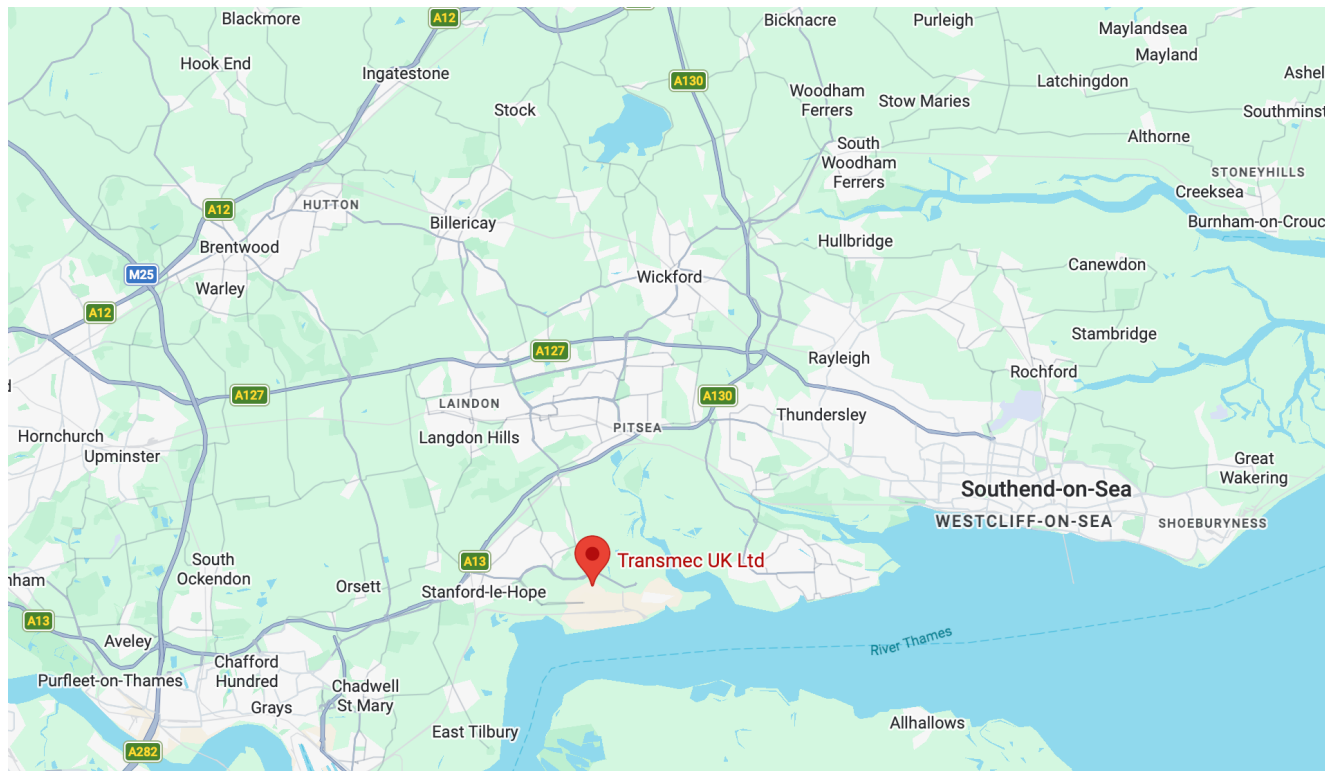

Put this in your sat nav or Google maps:

**Transmec UK Ltd Gateway Logistics Centre, N Sea Crossing, Corringham,
London SS17 9ER**





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By car

Put **SS17 9ER – Transmec UK Ltd, Gateway Logistics Centre, North Sea Crossing** into your sat-nav rather than simply “London Gateway,” because the wider complex covers a large area.

From the **M25**, leave at **Junction 30** and take the **A13 eastbound** toward Tilbury/Basildon/Grays. Continue for about **7 miles**, then take the **A1014 / Manorway Junction / Stanford Interchange** exit.

At the roundabout take the **3rd exit onto A1014 The Manorway**, continue toward London Gateway, then follow signs into the **Logistics Park** and for **North Sea Crossing / Gateway Logistics Centre**.

Simplified: M25 J30 → A13 East → A1014/The Manorway → London Gateway Logistics Park → North Sea Crossing → Transmec UK Ltd.



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Train

From **central London**, make your way to **London Fenchurch Street** and take a **c2c train toward Southend/Shoeburyness**, getting off at **Stanford-le-Hope (SFO)**. National Rail confirms Stanford-le-Hope station is on London Road, SS17 0JX.

From **Stanford-le-Hope station**, Transmec is still several miles away inside the London Gateway Logistics Park, so the easiest final leg is **bus**.

The pedestrian/cycle access toward London Gateway starts from Stanford-le-Hope via the Hardie Park subway and The Manorway.

Route: London Fenchurch Street → Stanford-le-Hope → bus → North Sea Crossing → Transmec.



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Bus

The useful public-transport connection is via **Stanford-le-Hope**. National Rail lists bus connections at Stanford-le-Hope station.

From the station/town centre, take a **London Gateway-bound local bus** and get off at the most convenient stop for the **London Gateway Logistics Park**. From there, continue toward **North Sea Crossing / Gateway Logistics Centre**.

Because bus routes and timetables can change—and the logistics park is large, we recommend checking the exact bus and stop for the time you're travelling rather than relying on an old route number.
